



ANTI-CORRUPTION POLICY STATEMENT INLAND REVENUE BOARD OF MALAYSIA

Inland Revenue Board of Malaysia (IRBM) always strives to instill and strengthen integrity values in the combat against bribery, abuse of power and misappropriation. IRBM also committed to:

- a. Carry out duties professionally, with integrity and not get involve in any corrupt practices.
- b. Comply with the provision of Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission Act (Act 694) as well as all laws, regulations, procedures and other directives in force related to anti-corruption.
- c. Implement MS ISO 37001:2016 Anti-Bribery Management Systems (ABMS) in IRBM effectively and meet the requirements set to combat bribery, protect IRBM's and stakeholders interest in achieving IRBM's vision and mission.
- d. Implement the IRBM Anti-Corruption Plan (PeARL) initiatives in order to achieve the IRBM's anti-corruption objectives.
- e. Create channel for complaints and report on bribery and guarantee the safety and confidentiality of complainant's information through IRBM's Whistleblowing Policy.
- f. Ensure continuous evaluation and improvement of the implementation of MS ISO 37001:2016 ABMS.
- g. Ensure the Integrity Division of Integrity and Risk Management Department carry out their duties independently and transparently to ensure the effective implementation of IRBM's ABMS and establish cooperation with the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission to strengthen initiatives in preventing and combating bribery in IRBM.
- h. Take action based on the Inland Revenue Board of Malaysia Disiplinary Regulations 2008 if it is found that IRBM officers are not in compliance with this Anti-Corruption Policy or any other IRBM's directives in force related to anti-corruption.
