1. RETURN FORM FILING PROGRAMME FOR THE YEAR 2025

Return Form (RF) Filing Programme For The Year 2025 has been uploaded on HASiL's official portal providing taxpayers with a reference and guide for submitting their Return Form for the year 2025.

Taxpayers of all categories are encouraged to refer to this programme as a guide in order to ensure a smooth tax reporting process with HASiL.

2. UNDERSTANDING EMPLOYER'S RESPONSIBILITIES IN FACILITATING YOUR TAX MATTERS

Employers play a role as facilitators in employee tax matters, particularly concerning Monthly Tax Deduction (MTD). In addition, employers are also responsible for:

- a) **SUBMISSION** of statement by employers for the relevant year's remuneration through Form e-E:
 - i) Form E will only be considered complete if C.P.8D is submitted on or before the due date filing of Form e-E
 - ii) Form C.P.8D can be submitted via :
 - e-Data Prais :
Must be uploaded in txt file format **on or before 25 February 2025**; or
 - e-CP8D :
Must be uploaded in txt file format **on or before due date for filing form e-E**.
- b) **PREPARE AND RENDER :**
 - i) Statement of remuneration (Form EA/ EC) for the respective employee on or before the last day of February the following year. For the year 2024, employers must provide it to employee **on or before 28 February 2025**, and
 - ii) Copy of statement of monetary and non-monetary incentive payment to each agent, dealer or distributor (Form CP58) on or before 31 March of the following year.

As an employee, you are advised to regularly review and update your personal information in case of any changes to ensure a smoother tax process. Make sure that the amount of MTD contribution displayed in your income statement, matches the amount contributed by your employer to HASiL. PCB contributions can be checked through e-Lejar system, which is accessible via MyTax, <https://mytax.hasil.gov.my/>.

If there are any discrepancies in Form EA/ EC, employees are advised to refer to their employer for a review and amendments if necessary.

3. NEW IN MYTAX

a) e-PCB PLUS : MERGER OF PCB E-SERVICES

Starting January 2025, e-PCB Plus, which combines the e-PCB, e-Data PCB and e-CP39 systems will begin to be used by employers with a more user-friendly and accessible interface. With e-PCB Plus, all aforementioned systems can be accessed under one platform through the MyTax application using the same ID and password.

b) TIN SEARCH FUNCTION

The Tax Identification Number (TIN) search platform can now be accessed via the MyTax Portal (<https://mytax.hasil.gov.my>) starting 1 January 2025. Taxpayers can search for their TIN by entering information according to the following categories:

- i) Individual : Identification Number (Identification Card Number/ Passport Number); and
- ii) Other than Individual : Business Registration Number (BRN) or Name of Taxpayer registered with HASiL for those without BRN.

HASiL also provides TIN search access on the MyTax Portal using MyDigital ID for identity verification. This feature is only available to Malaysian citizens.

4. ESTABLISHMENT OF FOREIGN TAXPAYERS BRANCH

Foreign Taxpayers Branch (CPCA) has been established and is operating at Blok 8, Kompleks Kerajaan Jalan Tuanku Abdul Halim, Kuala Lumpur starting 1 January 2025.

The establishment of this special branch is to enhance efficiency and effectiveness of tax operations relating to foreign individual taxpayers, non-residents and withholding tax, where CPCA will also focus on handling cases involving non-resident entertainers, foreign crews, and foreign visitors.

The CPCA takes over the taxation functions related to the files of foreign taxpayers, non-residents, and withholding tax from HASiL Negeri Wilayah Persekutuan Kuala Lumpur, HASiL Negeri Wilayah Persekutuan Putrajaya, and HASiL Negeri Selangor.

E-INVOICE PHASE 2

To support the growth of the digital economy, the implementation of e-Invoice will be carried out in stages to improve the efficiency of tax administration management in Malaysia. This is in line with the 12th Malaysia Plan, where one of its main focuses is to strengthen digital services infrastructure and digitise tax administration.

e-Invoice will enable the verification and storage of transactions in near real-time, catering to Business-to-Business (B2B), Business-to-Consumer (B2C) and Business-to-Government (B2G) transactions.
