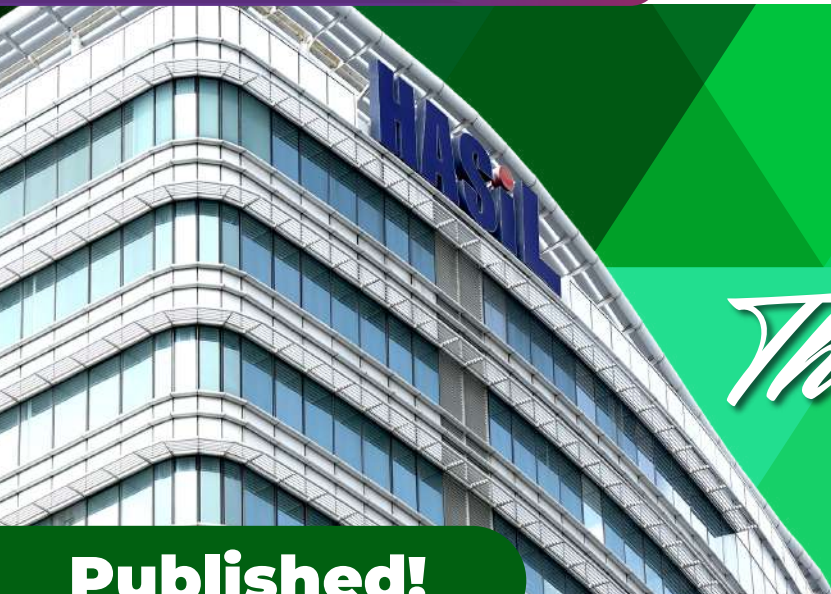
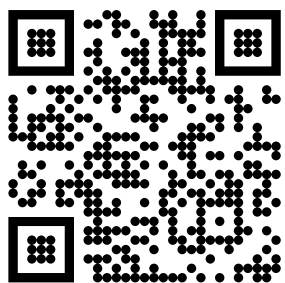

Extension Of The

Stamp Duty Special Voluntary
Disclosure (SVDP) Programme 2026



Extended For 6 Months

**Starting 1 July to
31 December 2026**

This Extension Reflects HASiL's Commitment to:

- Encourage voluntary compliance with stamp duty obligations.
- Provide taxpayers with sufficient time to adapt to the implementation of the Stamp Duty Self Assessment System (STSDS).
- Reduce non-compliance with the provisions of the Stamp Act 1949.

STSDS has taken effect from 1 January 2026.

- Self-assess and pay.
- Fast, simple and no Assessment Notice required.
- All stamping processes via **MyTax**

Phased Rollout (2026 - 2028)

2026: Tenancy/Lease, Securities, General Instruments.

2027: Transfer of Real Property (Without JPPH Valuation).

2028: Other Instruments.

Eligible Instruments

All instruments
executed between

1 January 2023
to
31 December 2025

Stamping and stamp duty
payment must be made between

1 January 2026
to
31 December 2026

Eligible Duty Payers: Malaysian citizens and Non-Malaysian citizens

Benefits of the Stamp Duty Special Voluntary Disclosure Programme (SVDP)

- Waiver of penalties (except in cases involving fraud).
- The instrument will not be subjected to audits.

Do not forget to submit your stamping application and make payment of the stamp duty early, this will ensure that the notice of assessment can be issued within the SVDP period and the stamp duty payment can be made within the stipulated timeframe.

Mandatory Submission Through The e-Derma System

As part of efforts to enhance the delivery of digital services, the **e-Derma System** was introduced to facilitate Institutions and Organisations (IOs) in submitting applications for approval under subsection 44(6) of the Income Tax Act 1967 (ITA 1967). The system has been available through the MyTax Portal since 20 August 2025.

e-Rayuan: Tax Assessment Appeal



Made Easier

Through **MyTax** Effective 1 June 2026

The submission of tax assessment appeals or applications for an extension of time to file an appeal against tax assessments raised under the **Income Tax Act 1967 (ITA 1967)** can now **be made online** through **e-Rayuan**.

The e-Rayuan facility does not apply to the following cases:

- Capital Gains Tax.
- Withholding Tax.
- Assessments raised as a result of investigation activities.

A Better Taxpayer Experience:

- Submit an appeal against an assessment or an application for an extension of time to appeal from anywhere, in real time;
- Track the status of an appeal against an assessment or an application for an extension of time throughout the processing period; and
- Receive notifications on case status, letters confirming acceptance or rejection, and notices approving the extension of time in a more systematic manner.

Special Programme

e-INVOICE Special Voluntary Disclosure Programme (SVDP)

1. Taxpayers can check, update and make corrections to e-Invoice transactions.
2. No penalties will be imposed for reviewing, updating, and correcting e-Invoice transactions.

**Beginning 7 July 2026
until 31 December 2027.**



Who is eligible to participate in this programme?

The programme is open to taxpayers who..

1. Have implemented e-Invoice in accordance with the prescribed timeline but have not issued e-Invoices for certain transactions..

2. Have issued e-Invoices but contain errors or information that does not comply with the prescribed specifications and requirements..

3. Have not issued e-Invoices for any period commencing from the mandatory e-Invoice implementation date.. and

4. Are subject to an e-Invoice compliance review.



How To Join This Program?

Taxpayers must use one of the following document versions when submitting e-Invoices or amendment documents:

- SVDP Version 1.2 (without a digital signature); or
- SVDP Version 1.3 (with a digital signature).



What incentives are provided to taxpayers who fully comply with the e-Invoice Implementation?

Accelerated tax incentive, full capital allowance can be claimed within one (1) year for qualifying expenditure related to e-Invoice implementation, including ICT expenses and the development or modification of software for e-Invoice implementation.
